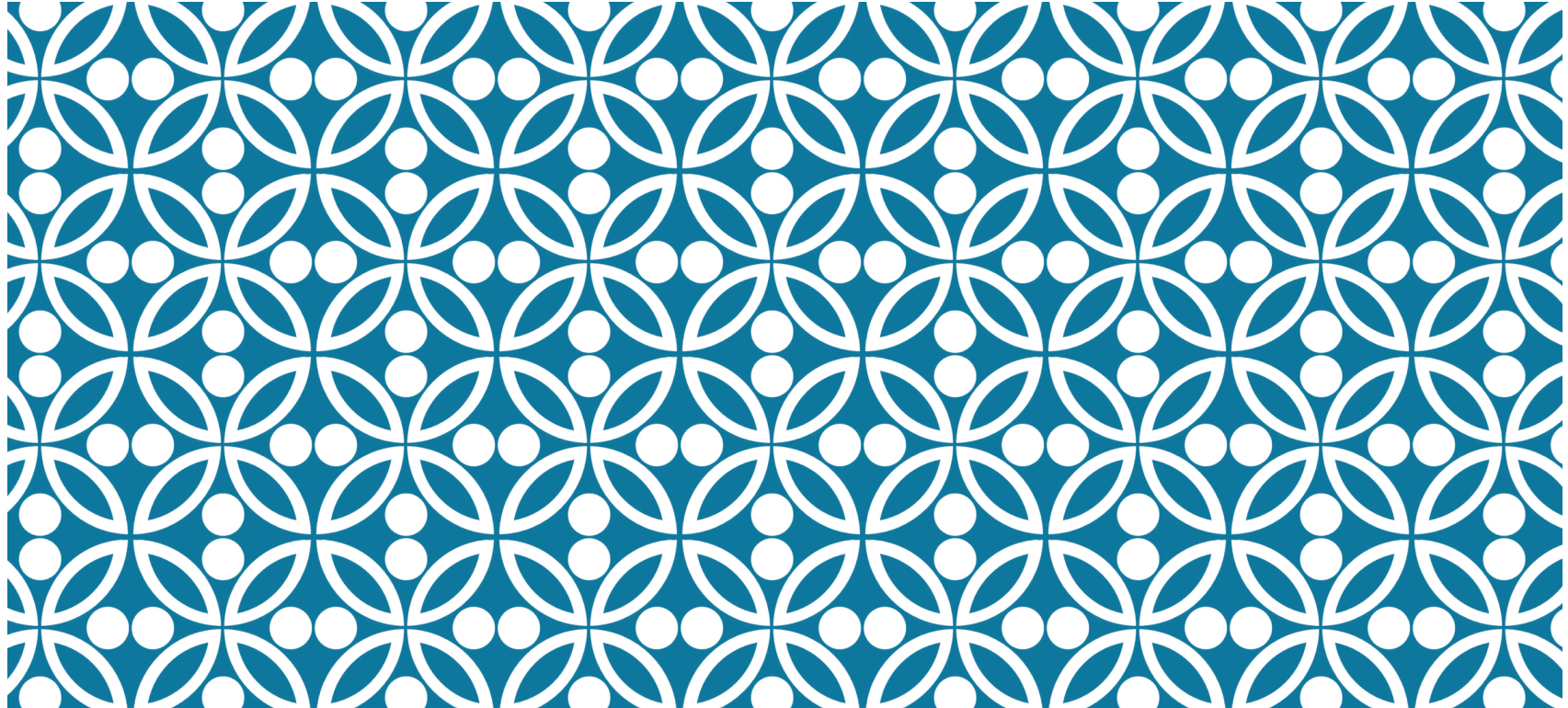
# WHEN CREATING A NEW ACCOUNT

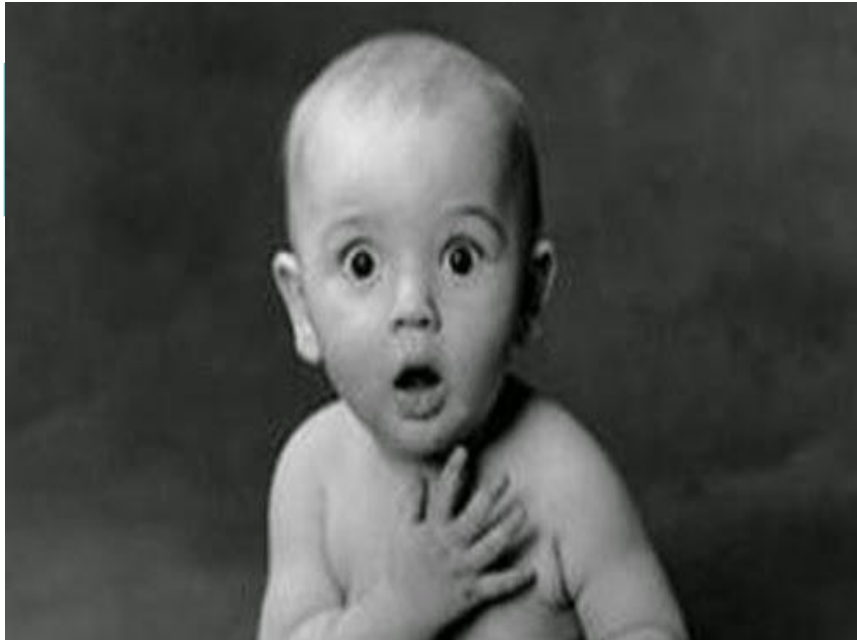

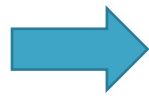
